# Songkran International Regatta 13 - 16 April 2017 at the Royal Varuna Yacht Club

## **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1. RULES

**1.1** The regatta is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race.

#### 2 ADVERTISING

**2.1** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

#### 3 VENUE

The Songkran International Regatta will take place at the Royal Varuna Yacht Club. Racing will take place immediately offshore between the RVYC and Koh Larn in the Gulf of Thailand. The RVYC is close to the city of Pattaya, approximately 1.5 hours drive from Bangkok Suvarnabhumi Airport.

## 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is only open to the Optimist class
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form and sending it to:

#### 5 FEES

**5.1** 300 baht entry fee is applicable for each participating sailor.

Prize giving will be immediately after the last race on April 16.

**6.2** Up to three races are scheduled per day, maximum of 12 races for the championship.

## 7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

**7.1** Event sailing instructions will be posted on the official noticeboard before registration.

#### 8 COURSES

**8.1** IODA trapezoid courses, standard trapezoid courses and windward/leeward will be used. The exact configuration will be displayed on the official noticeboard.

## 9 FORMAT

**9.1** Depending on the number of entries the organisers may consider splitting entries into fleets accordingly to method specified in the Sailing Instructions.

#### 10 SCORING

- **10.1** 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2 (a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
  - (b) When from 5 to 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
  - (c) When 11 to 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

#### 11 PRIZES

Prize categories will be posted on the official noticeboard.

## 12 LUNCHES

A basic Thai lunch and bottle of water will be provided to each sailor on the water.

#### 13 SAILING CONDITIONS

Wind: Frequently between 8KTS - 18KTS Temperature: 30C Tide: 2.5m range, 1 knot speed

## 14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover up to 10 million baht.

#### 16 CHARTER BOATS and OTHER FACILITIES

- **16.1** A limited supply of Optimists, Lasers and RIBs are available to charter.
- **16.2** Teams are welcome to use the RVYC facilities throughout April 2017, free of any charge.
- **16.3** Accommodation and full restaurant facilities are available onsite at the RVYC.
