NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The 29th SEA Games Kuala Lumpur 2017 Sailing Competition will be organised by the Malaysia Sailing Association with the support of the Malaysia SEA Games Organising Committee (MASOC), World Sailing (WS) and ASAF (Asian Sailing Federation).

2. LANGUAGE

English shall be the official language, and if there is conflict between languages, the English text will prevail.

3. RULES

- 3.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the World Sailing (WS) Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017 – 2020.
- 3.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 3.3 The SEA Games Federation Statutes and Rules will apply.
- 3.4 The 29th SEA Games Sailing Technical Handbook will apply.
- 3.5 The 29th SEA Games Sailing Notice of Race will apply.
- 3.6 The 29th SEA Games Sailing Instructions & Measurement Regulations will apply.
- 3.7 The Rules of the Respective Classes will apply.

- 3.8 For fleet racing, RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for RRS 42 will apply.
- 3.9 For medal races, RRS Addendum Q, Umpired Fleet Racing will apply and will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 3.10 For team racing, RRS Appendix D will apply.

4. ADVERTISING

- 4.1 Competitor advertising will be restricted to WS Regulation 20.
- 4.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

5. EVENTS

The 29th SEA Games Sailing Competition will be contested in the following events :

Men

- (i) Laser Standard
- (ii) Laser Radial
- (iii) International 470
- (iv) International 420 (U19) - born after 31st December 1998.
- (v) Optimist (U16) - born after 31st December 2001.
- (vi) Windsurfing RS:One
- (vii) Team Racing Dinghy in Laser Standard

Women

- (i) Laser Radial
- (ii) International 470
- (iii) International 420 (U19) - born after 31st December 1998.
- (iv) Optimist (U16) - born after 31st December 2001.
- (v) Windsurfing RS:One
- (vi) Team Racing Dinghy in Laser Radial

Mixed

- Team Racing in Optimist (U16) - born after 31st December 2001.

6. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 6.1 The 29th SEA Games Sailing competition is reserved for athletes representing the National Olympic Committee (NOC) affiliated to the SEA Games Federation. Only athletes who comply with the conditions laid down in the SEA Games Federation Charter and Rules and WS Rules are entitled to participate.

6.2 Each NOC may enter a maximum of twenty-two (22) athletes and eight (8) team officials. The maximum limit of athletes for each event are as follows:

- Laser Standard: One (1) male athlete
- Laser Radial: One (1) athlete per gender
- International 470: One (1) pair per gender
- Windsurfing RS:One: One (1) athlete per gender
- Optimist (U16): One (1) athlete per gender
- Team Racing in Optimist (U16): both athletes from the Optimist (U16) event and an additional three (3) athletes (male and/or female (U16).
- International 420 (U19): One (1) pair per gender
- Team Racing Dinghy in Laser Standard: One (1) male athlete from the Laser Standard event and an additional two (2) male athletes.
- Team Racing Dinghy in Laser Radial: One (1) female athlete from the Laser Radial event and an additional two (2) female athletes.

6.2 A registered substitute may replace an athlete only on medical grounds and with prior written permission from the WS Technical Delegate. Applications for the replacement must reach the Organising Authority before 1700 hours on the 07th August 2017 to be valid.

7. COMPETITION FORMAT

- 7.1 For fleet racing events, the sailing competition will consists of an opening series and a medal race.
- 7.2 For fleet racing events, the opening series will consist of a maximum of ten (10) races. The maximum number of races per day is Three (3).
- 7.3 For the Team Racing events, the sailing competition will consists of opening round robin series followed by a number of knockout rounds.

8.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the Practice Race is 14:30 and first race each day is 10:30 am.

9. MEASUREMENTS

Except for boats that are supplied by the Organising Authority, each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be made available before the Games.

11. VENUE

Attachment 1 shows the location of the National Sailing Centre, Langkawi, Kedah.

12. THE COURSES

- 12.1 The courses for fleet racing will be Trapezoid and Windward / Leeward course.
- 12.2 The courses for medal racing will be Windward / Leeward courses.
- 12.3 The courses for team racing will be either an inverted 'S' course or another course configuration approved by WS.

13. PENALTY SYSTEM

Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

14. SCORING

- 14.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 14.2 10 Races and 1 Medal Race are scheduled in all the Fleet Races.
- 14.3 Four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute an opening series.
- 14.4 When fewer than five (5) races in the opening series have been completed, no score shall be excluded.
- 14.5 When 5 or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 14.6 In medal races, a boat's score shall be double the number of points specified in RRS Appendix A4.1, and the score for that race shall not be excluded from the series score.
- 14.7 Ties in the series score between boats with different medal race point scores shall be broken in favour of the boat that scored better in the medal race. This changes RRS Appendix A8.

15. SUPPORT BOATS

- 15.1 Coach boats shall be registered at the Race Secretariat either before leaving the shore/dock for the first time or by 18:00 on the day before the first practice race of the event that is supporting, whichever is earlier.

15.2 Coach boats, team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall comply with the Coach Boat Regulations.

16. BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park / dock.

17. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

18. PRIZES

The 29th SEA Games 2017, Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second and third placings of each event respectively.

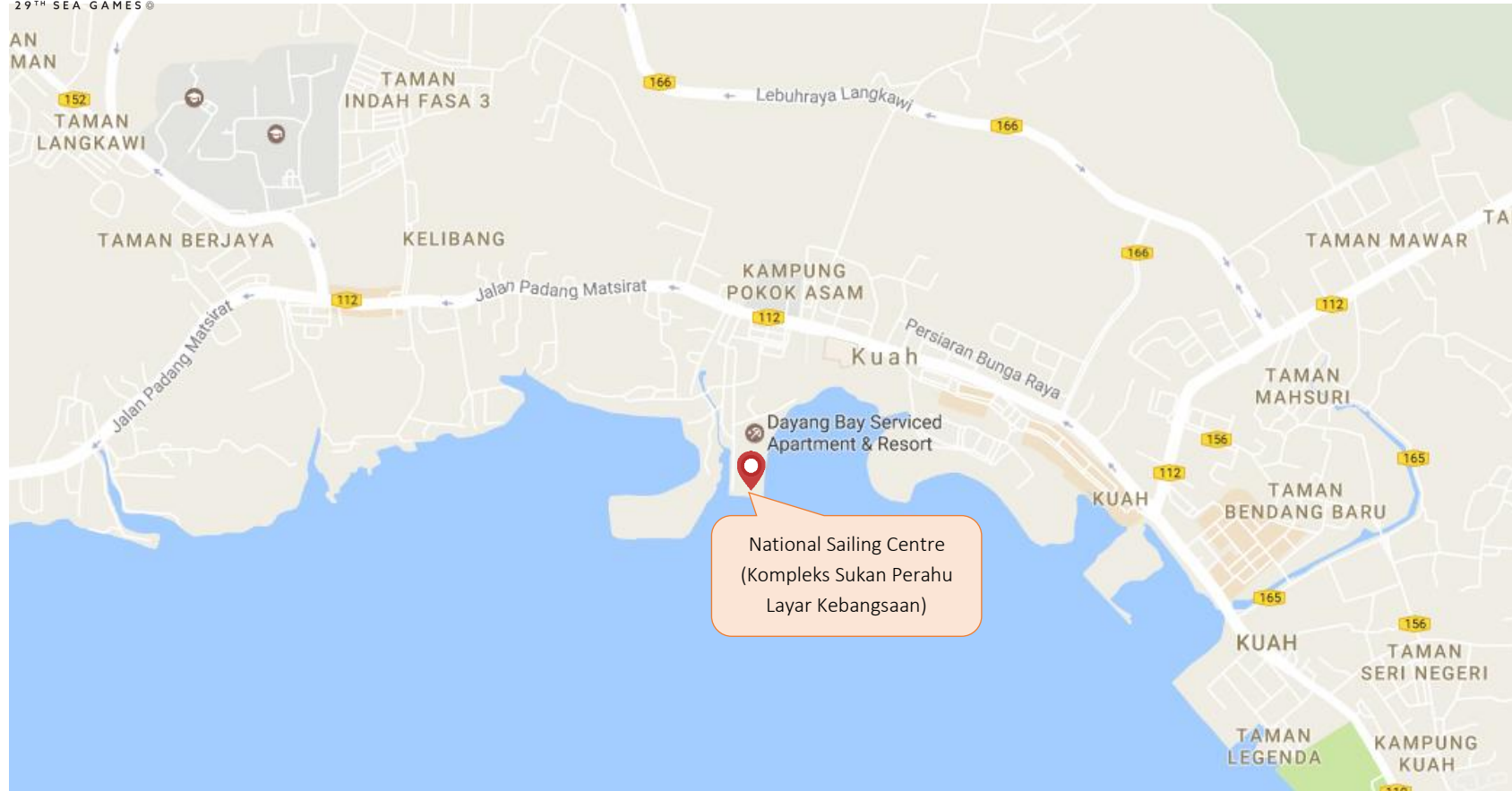
19. DISCLAIMER OR LIABILITY
