## ASAF Sailing Cup JSAF ENOSHIMA Olympic Week 2023

**From top to junior competitors, 263 boats including overseas teams are scheduled to participate**

The ASAF Sailing Cup JSAF Enoshima Olympic Week 2023, organized by the Japan Sailing Federation, will be held from June 22 (Thu.) to 25 (Sun.), at Enoshima Yacht Harbor (Fujisawa City, Kanagawa Prefecture).

This event has been held as an international race open to overseas competitors, for 45 years since its inauguration in 1977 to commemorate the 1964 Tokyo Olympics held in Enoshima. It is a World Sailing Grade 2 event, positioned as a high-level race attracting world championship sailors in each class and promising youth sailors.

This year's competition will be a high-level gathering of top sailors aiming for next year's Paris Olympics and the Los Angeles Olympics beyond, including Keiju Okada and Miho Yoshioka in the 470 class (winner of the 52nd Princess Sofia Cup held in Spain this March), who represented Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games, as well as the OP and 420 classes of junior and youth events, and the Snipe class that has produced many great sailors.

Not only Olympic class, but also various classes and athletes of all ages will participate from Japan and overseas.

Judges from Singapore, the U.S., India, Korea, and China will be invited to represent Asia in this international competition.

The Japan Sailing Federation is looking forward to the 50th anniversary of this event, and aims to make this event even more successful.

We hope that many athletes will compete in the world from Enoshima, the venue for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games.
